Road Fee Protest

Per California Government Code §66020, any party may protest the imposition of any fees, dedications, reservations or other exactions imposed on a development project. A development project is defined as “any project undertaken for the purpose of development. Development project includes a project involving the issuance of a permit for construction or reconstruction, but not a permit to operate.” California Government Code §66000.

Any protest of County of Orange (County) imposed road fee(s) must be received in writing within 90 calendar days after the fee imposition date or at the time of approval or conditional approval of the development. A Road Fee Protest must be written and include all the following information:

Basic Information

Applicant name, address, phone number, email address and description of the project’s purpose with the structure’s square footage and type (i.e. residential or commercial).

Statement of Protest

A statement on corporate letterhead describing that payment was tendered or will be tendered when due, any information to support factual elements for the protest, and the legal theory forming the basis for the protest.

Road Fee Program(s) Under Protest

Include the Road Fee Program(s) under protest and the imposed fee amount.

Copy of the Issued Permit

Copy of the Receipt of Payment for Issued Permit

Each request will be reviewed, and a formal response will be issued to the requestor within 90 calendar days from the date the full and completed documentation is received by the County.
